After the great success of the last 3rd IPI colloquium «Packaging Labeling» the next events are announced.



Feedback on IPI's 3rd colloquium «Packaging Labeling» which took place on 27 January 2007 has confirmed first impressions that the event was a considerable success. Around 40 delegates attended the talk given by Dietmar Dold, CEO of Videojet Technologies Suisse. In an hour-long presentation, followed by a question and answer session, Dietmar Dold set out why packaging is labelled, the range of available technologies as well as key decision-taking criteria for the manufacturer in the selection of the appropriate labelling and process. The main technologies used include ink-jet-, laser and thermotransfer printing – as well as labelling and addressing systems. Heinz Winzeler, who leads on School System Development at IPI and organised the colloquium, has announced the 4th colloquium on 8 June 2007.
